The CORCRC has several active committees that would welcome your help. Each committee is in need of people with a variety of skills particularly in marketing and social media. Here is a brief description of each committee's activities

**Clergy Outreach-** Consistent communication with supportive clergy includes providing legislative updates, educational resources and requests for pro-active participation in advocacy efforts.

**Counseling-** This committee is primarily responsible for the promotion of the counseling service and organizing an annual training for counselors and other professionals depending on the topic.

**Development-** Fundraising efforts include communicating with potential and existing donors and organizing events. The major fundraising event, Faith and Freedom award ceremony/reception is in May. This committee also works with the Executive Director on grant applications.

**Education-** In addition to creating educational materials, this committee promotes and organizes educational events (at least two a year) for the public.

**Legislative Committee-** Advocacy at the legislation and informing our supporters about legislative issues is the main focus of this committee. Annually, the committee helps to organize a Roe vs. Wade Anniversary event, Lobby Day. We will be hosting town hall meetings

**Newsletter-** a quarterly e-newsletter is prepared and delivered to all supporters.
