- Board and organizational development.
- Collaboration with the CORCRC Board of Directors.
- Collaboration with the National Religious Coalition for Reproductive Choice.

- Pro-Choice commitment to equitable access to abortion services and reproductive rights.
- Religious identity and involvement. Clergy preferred, but not required.
- Organizational skills: meeting deadlines, reporting, etc.
